### Morelia, Michoacan, Mexico Cathedral Church



Beginning on Monday, January 11th, I will be taking ten days in Mexico for vacation. I will be going to the UNESCO heritage city of Morelia, Michoacan. There are over 200 historic buildings and museums in the "old city," which is where I will be staying—right across from the Cathedral pictured above. If time and other considerations permit, I will be making some side trips to Lake Patzcuaro and the surrounding towns and villages, which specialize in a variety of handcrafts. I look forward to the rest, time to explore the religious and historic sites, and to practice my Spanish. Morelia is right in the center of the county at an elevation of 6399 feet above sea level.

During the time I am away, Tony Morris, pastoral assistant, will handle any pastoral and administrative issues that might arise. He will work with the Abbey and Missionaries and Carmelites to cover any sacramental needs. ### Church Stairs, Clarence Schmidt, & the Oktoberfest Board:

The powder-coating of the handrails should be complete by the time you read this and installation will occur as soon as possible. It has been a long journey through freezing temperatures and lots of rain to bring us to the point of completing the stairs. All this work was made possible by a major gift from the estate of Clarence Schmidt. When Clarence died just about a year ago, he made significant gifts to the Abbey, Providence Benedictine, and St. Mary's. The amount left to St. Mary's was \$421,700.00, which is ONLY to be used for repairs and maintenance of the church. This follows the gift of approximately \$87,000.00 two summers ago, which financed the replacement of the west parking area, sidewalks, and resurfacing and painting the south parking lot. The stairs will likely come in at \$116,269.00. For the last several years the Oktoberfest Board has awarded us three grants, totaling \$17,000.00 for repairs to the stairs. And so with that grant from Oktoberfest, and the remaining monies coming from the Clarence Schmidt Estate, St. Mary's received the gift of new stairs. The repairs to the heating system for the church, completed this summer, came to about \$44,863.00 and were also paid for from Clarence's estate. We have much to thank Clarence for his generosity to St. Mary's and for being able to make repairs and maintain the church for some years to come. Thank you, Clarence Schmidt and Chuck Eder, his Executor, for all the generosity & work!
