Message from the Pastors Asst...



From the readings this weekend, and from a personal experience that happen to me years ago at this very church on Christmas eve, marriage is brought clearly to mind. It was thirty four years ago that I was smitten by a young lady named Susie Radosevich. I had come to realize that I had a vocation to marry, but it was at

that Christmas eve mass that I came to realize who I would be living that vocation out with. It has been through my love and relationship with Susie that I have best understood my love and relationship with my God.

Take the reading from Isaiah "As a young man marries a virgin, your Builder shall marry you; and as a bridegroom rejoices in his bride, so shall your God rejoice in you". In John's Gospel the setting is a wedding feast. Jesus is there and is fundamentally important to it's success (with a little nudge from Mom). In Jesus' three year ministry, marriage is promoted and defended. Why is this vocation so important? As Pope John Paul the II would say "If we don't get marriage figured out, we will not figure out God" (Love and Responsibility).

Consider Edmund Spenser's poem *Epithalamion*, which was dedicated to his wedding day and his bride. A wedding for Spenser, is not a matter of consenting adults who like each other for awhile. All the cosmos is invited to share his joy, for a wedding is the act that binds together man and woman, reaching back in time to generations before and looking forward to generations to come.
