Message from the Pastor...

Now the Body is not a single part, but many.

For the last few weeks there has been an absence of two very great men in my life and the life of the parish. Their separation from us is only temporary, but none the less, a loss is felt everyday they are not with us. The first man I would like to call your attention to is Jerry Lauzon. It is really only in his absence that you fully realize all that he does and has done for the parish and the community. I notice his absence mostly in the morning. Very early in the morning! Jerry is the one that opens the church (around 6:00 AM) and sets up for morning Mass. He has been doing that for over twenty years. That kind of commitment is unheard of these days. Marriages don't even last that long. All the beautiful liturgies and altar server training that we have been blessed with at St. Mary Parish, have Jerry's finger prints on them. A sacristan's work is often unnoticed, unless it's not done. So many details are taken care of for us, so we can worship in the catholic traditions that we love. Candles, incense, bells, bread, wine, holy vessels and Scriptures are all taken care of with not a sign of the sacristan.

The second man is our good pastor. He was only gone one day and I was so glad God had not called me to the priesthood. I love assisting the pastor, but I'm so glad the "buck" stops with him. Fr. Philip has so many balls in the air at one time and never drops even one of them. I have been working under him for a year and a half and I continue to be amazed with his pastoral skill and care.

He has many talents, but the one I admire most is his funeral homilies. The way he can sit and talk to a family in their grief, listen to the stories they tell of their departed loved one and then bring the loved one back to life in his homily is beyond my understanding. He doesn't canonize them; he simply shows them in all their beautiful humanity. I hope I am taken to my heavenly reward before him, so he can preach at my funeral. He could even make a guy like me seem wonderful.

This weekend the second reading speaks of the "Body" having many parts. If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored; all the parts share its joy. I ask you to continue to pray for these two wonderful men in their sufferings and in their joys.
