This program is for girls ages 7 to 9 who are Brownies in the Girl Scouts. The purpose is to help children explore the wide range of activities to discover the presence of God in their daily lives as members of their family and parish. The time requirement is three to four months.

Finance Committee Meeting:

Last night, Tuesday, January 26th, the Finance Committee met for its regular monthly meeting to review the Parish Finances year to date. Our contributions to the parish are down approximately 10%. In order to remain in the black, we have been trimming costs an equal amount. That is simply good stewardship in challenging times. It needs to be added that while we have been doing all this, we have grown significantly. During the seven and a half years I have been pastor, we have gone from approximately 857 households and 2560 parishioners (as last recorded in the year 2000 Parish Pictorial Directory) to the current (as of today 1/27/10), 1247 households and 3915 parishioners. Religious Education—K-12—had approximately 250 in 2000, and now we have 433. While we will continue to be very responsible with the donations that are given to St. Mary's, it is clear that we have to work even harder at providing the services and facilities for all the needs that we are serving. Because of transitions and the need to shift some responsibilities, we will be looking to fill within the next month the position of bookkeeper and by April 1, a fulltime custodian who can care for all the facilities we have—taking care of cleaning, caring for the floors and carpets, set up and tear down for classes, receptions, etc. in the church, parish center, and parish office. Current staff will have some modifications made to own job descriptions to be current with our ever challenging situation of celebrating the Sacraments and Religious Education and Formation and Service. Please be generous when you can. It is appreciated.

Volunteers and Volunteerism

When I was young and fifth of eight children living on our family farm in Hillsboro and my parents were trying to send us all to Catholic Schools, there was no money to spare. One of the ways we “contributed” to the parish was volunteering or as we used to say, “Dad just ‘volunteered us’ again for.....at the parish.” It was the way in which, while might not have money to give, we could give our time and talents. When these invitations come from St. Mary's, please step forward.
