Wursthfest

Wursthfest, a celebration of the mighty German (wurst) sausage, takes place in the Oktoberfest Community Building, 500 S Wilco Hwy, on Friday, September 12, from 5:00 p.m. 'till 11:00 p.m. Saturday, February 13, from noon 'til 11:00 p.m. and Sunday, February 14, from noon 'til 6:00 p.m. This is the weekend before Ash Wednesday and the start of the austere, Holy Season of Lent.

Abbot Gregory Duerr, OSB Coat of Arms

The shield is divided into two halves known as "impaling", joining the arms of Engelberg & Mount Angel Abbeys on one side, with that of the personal arms of Abbot Gregory on the other. The background, or field, utilizes elements associated with the Abbot's maternal and paternal families. In the top portion the red field with a large gold (yellow) vertical stripe is borrowed from arms associated with the name Duerr (Dürr).

In the bottom portion of the shield the green field with three horizontal bars as well as the dividing line looking like the parapet of a castle wall suggests the arms associated with the name Fleckenstein, the Abbot's maternal family name. Prominent in the upper portion is the descending dove of the Holy Spirit. This is an allusion to the Abbot's monastic patron saint, Pope St. Gregory the Great who, in art, is often seen with the dove that symbolizes the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. In addition, the dove, a symbol of peace, refers back to Abbot Gregory's chosen motto, "He Shall Be Peace" (Micah 5:5).

Abbot Gregory's Blessing will be February 26, 2010 at the Abbey
