Archbishop's Catholic Appeal 2010



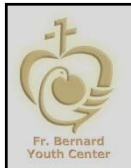

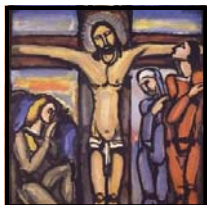
The Holy Season of Lent 2010

REGULATIONS FOR LENT

Abstinence from meats is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

The special Lenten fast and abstinence are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday. By the threefold discipline of fasting, almsgiving and prayer the Church keeps Lent from Ash Wednesday until the evening of Holy Thursday.



This year we will again have Friday Stations of the Cross beginning at 6:00 p.m. on February 19th in the Church, followed by Soup Supper in the Parish Center. It is a great time to hand on to your children some of the devotional/prayerful heritage of the Church—and you don't have to worry who is going to cook on Friday evenings!
