## Message from the Pastor...

### Immigration Legislation & Reform

With the expectation that comprehensive immigration reform could soon be considered by Congress, it is important that supporters of reform make their voices heard on Capitol Hill. For this reason, the Justice for Immigrants Campaign has initiated a postcard campaign to urge Congress to pass reform legislation.



The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has launched a postcard campaign to Congress in support of immigration reform. It is anticipated that immigration reform could be considered in 2010. In order to participate in the campaign, postcards have been included with this bulletin. Once filled out, they can be returned to the office or to the baskets at the rear of church. Volunteers will take care of preparing them to be sent to Washington, DC.

This is an important public policy issue which impacts individuals and families who are a part of St. Mary's Parish and we encourage you to participate in the campaign. Names to fill in for Senators from Oregon are: Ron Wyden and Jeff Merkley and our Representative for the 5th District is Kurt Schrader. Please write these in and then your name and address to complete the postcards.

### Bookkeeper & Custodian Positions

As many of you have heard, we are looking for a person to fill the job of Parish Bookkeeper. The job description has been revised with input from our interim bookkeeper Frits Van Gent, and the Finance Committee. It is a 20–25 hr per week position.



We are also looking for a full-time parish custodian. With the amount of activities happening in our buildings and the need to set up and break down after each event, as well as keeping everything properly clean and maintained, this person will be working 40 hrs. per week.

If you or someone you know is interested in either of these positions, please stop by the Office and pick up a job description and application form. Applicants must be able to fulfill the job description, but also successfully complete a background check and *Safe Environment Training*, required by the Archdiocese. The Finance Committee members will be assisting me in reviewing the applications, selecting the finalists, and interviewing and hiring. Please keep us in prayer.
