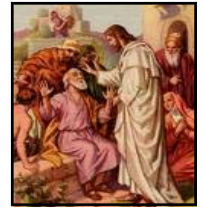

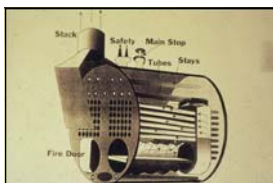
Message from the Pastor...

New Custodian at St. Mary's

Since the beginning of April, our new full-time custodian has been busy cleaning and getting to know the physical plant of St. Mary's and the many duties associated with all the activities we have. HERIBERTO RODRIGUEZ, or as we call him, **EDDIE**, has been a member of our parish since I came eight years ago. He and his family regularly attend the Spanish Charismatic Group and he helps with music at the Spanish Mass on several Sundays. Eddie scored the highest among all the applicants for the position in terms of his knowledge of and use of janitorial materials. He also has a background in plumbing, carpentry, and mechanics that he brings to the position. Eddie is married to Daena who works at the PBNC, and he has two sons, Erick and Brandon. They live in Aumsville. Please remember in your prayers Eddie and Daena's son, Erick. He has been diagnosed with leukemia. Recently Erick had some tests which indicate he may need to have a bone marrow transplant. He is being treated at Emanuel Hospital, PDX. We look forward to many years of Eddie's service to St. Mary Parish. I want to thank Pete Paradis, Tony Morris, Felix Meraz, and Ray Bielemeier for all the work they did to write the job description, sort through the applicants, and the interviewing and testing of each applicant. BOILER REPAIRS : Heating in the Church



If you have noticed that it has been a little cooler in the church the last two weeks, it is because we have needed repairs to the boiler. The boiler only heats the church. (The parish center is on a heat-pump system). What seems to have happened is that the "pan" under the fire box of the boiler, as you can see in the illustration, finally rusted out. Our boiler was not an easy one to maintain, and over the years the accumulation of sediments and minerals in that environment ate through the 1/4 inch steel. LANZ INDUSTRIAL WELDING came in, cut out the entire bottom, and they are in the process of making and welding in a new bottom to the furnace that will be 3/8 inch steel to put us back in business. This project will likely cost about \$10,000.00 for all the man hours and materials and testing. Thank you for your patience.

The FINANCE COUNCIL met last night (4/27/10) to review this project and our overall financial picture. Commendations to Michelle (and Frits) for the work they have done. As we near the end of the fiscal year (July to June) we will produce a report indicating income and expenses and restricted gifts. We strive to be good stewards of what you give. It is just very expensive to maintain our physical plant, and to run a very large religious education program, sacramental preparation program, and services to parishioners. Your generosity to our weekly collection & parish support is always appreciated.
