The Word of God.

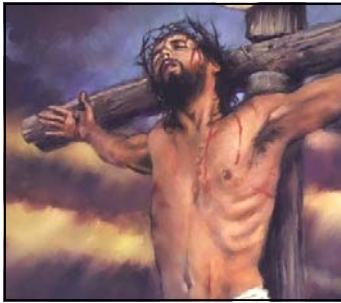
