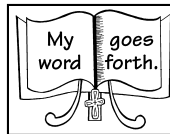

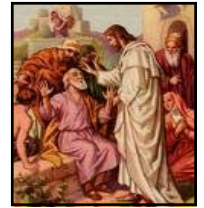

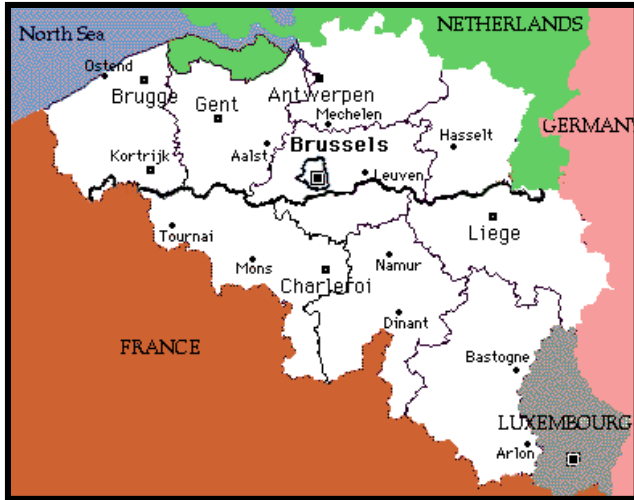


#### MINISTRY TO THE SICK

## Message from the Pastor...



### Back from Belgium...

I had a wonderful vacation in Belgium, staying in Brussels at a very reasonable B&B not far from downtown. The trip was very much a combination of tourism and pilgrimage, especially so when I visited and prayed at the tomb of St. Fr. Damien (the leper) of Molokai. Pater Damiaan or Heilige Damiaan van Molokai; born Jozef De Veuster, is buried in Leuven (Louvain), an historic university city close to the village where St. Damien was born. [\*Both French and Dutch are official languages of Belgium, though English is spoken quite freely by most.]

Much of the vacation was in the form of day trips by train to Brugges, Ghent, Lueven, Antwerp, and Luxembourg City. In each I visited the museums and cathedrals and other churches and religious sites. The paintings, architecture, and culture were a feast for the eyes, mind and soul.

Daniel Zene Crowe, who grew up in Mt. Angel and has been with the Army in Germany for some time now, traveled from Nuremburg, Germany, with his fiancé, Er. Together we went to Brugges for the day.

And so while it was a wonderful break, it is really great to be back again among you all. While Belgium is nominally 80% Catholic, less than 20% go to church, evident especially when one goes to church and sees so few people and even fewer young people. All the more reason for me to appreciate the great community that makes up St. Mary's, a community that most cathedrals there could only dream of having.
