

SAINT REPORT

ONE OF THE TRADITIONAL PRACTICES IN THE CHURCH AT THE TIME OF CONFIRMATION IS TO CHOOSE A NAME OF A SAINT THAT WILL REMIND YOU OF THE SACRAMENT.

YOUR PRAYERFUL REFLECTION WILL HELP YOU DECIDE ON THAT NAME.

THIS NEW NAME SIGNIFIES YOUR NEW AND DEEPER AWARENESS OF WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A DISCIPLE OF JESUS CHRIST AND CREATES A SPECIAL BOND BETWEEN YOU AND THE CHOSEN SAINT.

THE NORMS FOR CONFIRMATION INDICATE YOU SHOULD CHOOSE THE NAME OF A SAINT WHOM YOU ADMIRE , WHOM YOU CAN PRAY TO FOR INTERCESSION, AND WHO INSPIRES YOU TO IMITATE CHRIST.
