St. Mary's & Holy Rosary Holy Week Schedule

Beginning next Sunday we enter into the final days of Lent and enter into Holy Week, Triduum, and Easter Vigil & Easter Sunday.

PALM SUNDAY: Regular Sunday Mass Schedule at both St. Mary's & Holy Rosary with Procession of Palms at St. Mary's, weather permitting. We begin in the parish center with the blessing of palms.

CHRISM MASS at the CATHEDRAL: Monday evening Mass in Portland, celebrated by Archbishop Vlazny and priest concelebrants from all over the Archdiocese, begins at 7:00 pm. At this Mass, Oil of the Catechumens, Oil of the Sick, and Sacred Chrism are blessed and then distributed to each parish for use in the Sacraments.

HOLY THURSDAY: Bi-Lingual Mass at 7:00 pm This is the Mass of the Lord's Supper, a special time of remembering the institution of the Eucharist. At this Mass is the "mandatum," the washing of feet, in memory of Jesus' own service for his own. Eucharistic Procession to the parish center for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight.

GOOD FRIDAY: The Passion Narrative, Veneration of the Cross (with a relic of the True Cross), and Holy Communion; will be done in two services: in English at 3:00 pm and in Spanish at 7:00 pm.

EASTER VIGIL: Begins Saturday evening at 8:30 pm. At this most Sacred of Liturgies, we have Baptisms, Receptions into the Church, Confirmation, and Reception of First Eucharist for over 30 persons, each receiving the Sacraments according to their preparation and age and need. English and Spanish will be used in the Liturgy.

EASTER SUNDAY: Regular Schedule of Sunday Masses at St. Mary's and Holy Rosary.
