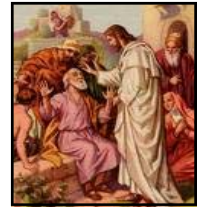

In the parish, we are going to parallel that program. Together we have assigned a virtue to every week of the year. This will be our parish theme for *CELEBRATIONS OF FAITH* this coming year, as well as *ZIP-LOCKED CATECHESIS*. Right now we are looking at a virtue a week for adults, high school, and junior high. The K-5 group will focus on a virtue each month. And we will work on a home-kit or Zip-Locked Catechesis to bring **VIRTUE FIRST** program into each household.
